



EUDR Update - November 2025

Dear Customers,

We would like to provide you with an update on the European Union Deforestation Regulation (EUDR – EU 2023/1115) and the ongoing preparations within the Europapier Group to ensure full compliance and maintain transparent, deforestation-free sourcing practices.

Status of the Regulation

We are pleased to inform you that Europapier Group uphold its commitment to deforestation-free sourcing practices.

Based on the latest information from the EU Commission and Parliament, the exact start as well as the final framework of the EUDR Regulatory is still unclear.

Although the EUDR implementation timeline may shift, our dedication to sustainability remains unwavering.

Europapier Group's Readiness

The Europapier Group will be prepared to meet EUDR requirements.

- IT systems are on the way to be adapted to receive, manage, and distribute EUDR Reference Numbers (RNs).
- EUDR Reference Numbers will be provided as soon as available.

Below, we want to give you a first impression of how Europapier will label EUDR-relevant products.

What are EUDR-relevant products?

All commercial products under customs tariff numbers 47* and 48* that contain pulp and the raw material (wood) of which was harvested after the regulation came into effect.

What are non-EUDR-relevant products?

All commercial products under customs tariff numbers 47* and 48* that contain pulp and the raw material (wood) of which was harvested before the regulation came into effect, as well as all products under the mentioned tariff numbers that consist entirely of recycled material; furthermore, all materials not covered by the aforementioned customs tariff numbers (VISCOM, hygiene; etc.) are not EUDR-relevant as well.

This includes all products (wood, pulp, and paper) stored at Europapier and its upstream suppliers as of the regulation's effective date.

Europapier will provide DDS reference and verification numbers for EUDR-relevant products with our shipping documents.


Additionally, a QR code will be printed to allow easy access to these numbers.

What does this mean for the labeling of our deliveries?

At the start of the EUDR, no products will be labeled with a DDS number, as the inventory across the entire supply chain will still originate from the previous period (EU Timber Regulation or EUTR).

- In intra-European trade, EUTR goods must not be labeled with a reference number.
- For imports or exports into or out of the EU, assigning a so-called dummy reference number to EUTR goods is permitted.

As EUTR inventories are gradually depleted, the number of products subject to EUDR will increase, and accordingly, the number of products we are allowed to label with a reference number will grow.

Europapier is not legally authorized nor obligated to label all deliveries with a reference number from the start of the EUDR.
